REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The 2022 Festival Workshops will be held in person—with the following exception: Pietro Accardi is teaching Articulated Binding via live Zoom on Friday April 22.

We are finalizing a few **Lecture workshops** similar to those offered in the September's Virtual Festival. In these prerecorded lectures, the instructor will work through a process, technique or structure. They will take you through all the steps, pass along some great tips and tricks, and provide you with a materials and tools list. The lecture will be recorded and you will have access to watch it as many times as you like until July 1, 2022. This is a great way to learn more about a technique without a large commitment. Cost of each lecture will be \$45.

Registration for these lectures will begin February 21. There is no limit to the number of people that can register for each lecture.

Evening Activities will be announced closer to the Festival—they will include some live Zoom Events.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

WORKSHOP REGISTRATION FEES are based on the number of days you take workshops. The more days you take workshops, the less it costs per day.

One Day – \$140 total

Two Days – \$230 total

In addition to registration fees, each workshop has a materials fee.

These are listed in the workshop descriptions.

Three Days - \$295 total

Four Days - \$360 total

TWO-DAY WORKSHOPS There are four two-day workshops being offered. These count as two days in registration fees. The materials fee covers both days.

WORKSHOP HOURS All workshops meet from 9:00am to noon and 1:30-4:30pm. You *may not* enter your classroom until 8:50am.

REGISTRATION will open at 9am Saturday January 29th

HOW TO REGISTER Registration is online only via Google Forms. The time and date stamp will determine your place in the registration queue. Please take the time to read the rest of the registration information.

Things to know:

- You must fill out the form in one sitting.
- You must answer every question.
- If you enter a wrong answer just enter the correct one and the wrong one will be deleted.
- Once you have submitted the form, you cannot go back and change your answers.
- Your form has not been submitted until you see the following:

If this does not appear, scroll up and confirm that all the questions have been answered.



Registering for 2-Day Workshops

- Select the workshop on both days as your first, second or third choice.
- They count as two days in registration fees.
- The materials fee covers both days.

REGISTER EARLY Historically most registrations happens on the first day. Include second and third choices. If you do not get into your first choice and have not included second and third choices, you will not be registered for those day(s). The last day to register or change workshops is April 7, 2022.

WAITING LISTS A waiting list is kept for each workshop equal to the maximum number of students for that workshop. If someone cancels, that spot will be offered to the first person on the waiting list. When a class is WAITLIST ONLY, it is recommended that you provide second and/or third choices.

REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION Within three days of completing your registration you will receive an email from *OCCA with the subject line: You received a new invoice.* The invoice will list the workshops you are registered in, registration fees and materials fees.

Payment is due within 48 hours of receiving your invoice. There is a link in the invoice to the *Square Payment Portal*. Square accepts all major credit and debit cards. If payment is not received within 48 hours of your invoice arriving, your registration will be forfeited. If you prefer to pay by check, email Sara at ssiggelkow@coatarts.org for instructions.

FESTIVAL CREDITS A number of you have a festival credit. The credit will be applied to your invoice.

REFUND POLICY If you cannot attend a workshop for which you have registered, let us know immediately. We will gladly refund your registration minus a \$45 fee. There will be no refunds after March 12, 2022. The Oregon Coast Council for the Arts reserves the right to cancel workshop(s).

\$25 FOR THE 25TH PROJECT



Cheri Aldrich and friends are organizing the \$25 for the 25th project to help support the *Friends of the Festival*. They are asking for donations of paper-related art pieces that will be displayed on the wall in a grid pattern. Pieces should be no larger than 8" x 10" (smaller is fine) and not deeper than about an inch. Items will be tucked into seethrough pockets. These donated pieces will be sold for \$25, with the entire amount going to Friends of the Festival. Art will be displayed at the Newport Visual Arts Center, March 12-April 23, 2022. This will be an "Off the Wall" show, allowing people to take the art home with them that day. Items are needed by February 26 for the show opening, and by March 26 for inclusion in the month of April. FRIENDS OF THE FESTIVAL

As part of the Festival's 25th Anniversary, the Oregon Coast Council for the Arts has formed the Friends of the Festival patron group. Join the Friends of the Festival and support the project's growth and sustainability. Friends of the Festival will be offering scholarships for the 2023 Festival.

If you are not currently a Friend of the Festival you can join during registration.

Become a Friend of the Festival

\$25 level - Thank you for becoming a Friend of the Festival.

\$50 level - Friends of the Festival enjoy a 5% discount on festival registration fees.

\$100 level - Friends of the Festival enjoy a 5% discount on festival registration fees and a 10% discount on any artwork purchased during the festival (excluding \$25 for the 25th items).

\$250 level - Friends of the Festival enjoy a 10% discount on festival registration fees, a 10% discount on any artwork purchased during the festival (excluding \$25 for the 25th items) and recognition on the festival website and brochure.

\$500 - Friends of the Festival enjoy a 15% discount on festival registration fees, a 10% discount on any artwork purchased during the festival (excluding \$25 for the 25th items) and recognition on the festival website and brochure.

WAITLIST ONLY This early in the registration process there will be movement between workshops and frequently people will get into a workshop off of the waitlist. We highly recommend including second and third options when registering.

VACCINATION AND MASK REQUIREMENTS

The safety and well-being of our patrons, artists, volunteers, and staff has been, and always will be, a top priority of the Oregon Coast Council for the Arts. Given the increase in COVID-19 cases and illness in the state of Oregon, and in keeping with new industry norms and best practices, the Newport Paper & Book Arts Festival will require proof of full vaccination for entry to all workshops. All participants, staff, artists and volunteers will need to provide this information as a condition of participation. Mask wearing is also required for all individuals.

This requirement extends until further notice and is subject to review and change according to federal, state, and city recommendations and guidelines.

FULLY VACCINATED: Means that the festival is at least 14 days after your final vaccine dose.

FACE MASKS: Required for all, while inside in the workshop venues, galleries, and evening activities, except while actively eating or drinking in designated areas only. A properly worn mask completely covers the nose and mouth, is secured to the head, and fits snugly against the sides of the face. Gaiters, bandanas, face shields, or masks with an exhalation valve are not acceptable. Compliant masks will be available should you need one.

WHAT FORMS OF VACCINATION PROOF ARE ACCEPTED?

A CDC Vaccination Record Card (physical or a photo) showing a completed vaccination series. Name and birthday must match your valid photo ID.

OTHER PRECAUTIONS TAKEN BY THE FESTIVAL FOR INCREASED SAFETY:

- Class size has been adjusted to a maximum of 12.
- Materials lists have been adjusted to decrease sharing when feasible.
- Rooms will be wiped down between workshops.
- There will not be catered lunches We suggest a brown bag lunch or we will provide a list of places you can order and pick up lunch before the workshop begins or during the lunch break. More information will be emailed to you in March.
- Evening activities will be adjusted for safety. The schedule will be announced closer to the Festival.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS:

For the safety of all we ask if you have been exposed to someone with COVID, are not feeling well, or you have tested positive for COVID within 7 days of the Festival you do not attend. Let us know right away and we will issue you a full refund.
